The first hydrogen bus reached Leh on 17 th August as part of 3-month-long process of fieldtrials, roadworthiness tests and other statutory procedures. This will be the India's first ever deployment of hydrogen buses on public roads. The first of its kind Green Hydrogen Mobility Project at 11,562 ft is colocated with dedicated Solar plant of 1.7 MW for providing renewable power. The fuel cell buses are designed for operation in sub-zero temperature in rarefied atmosphere, typical to such altitude locations which is a unique feature of this project.
